## Biography

I was born in bojnourd . 18<sup>th</sup> of July in 1998.

When I was an infant, we moved to Jajarm city because of my father's employment at the Alumina factory. My mother was 19 years old. At that time she had to take care of me on her own when she was away from her family. My father was often at work at night and both of us were alone at night. We did not have any relatives and friends in Jajarm.

I did not have any playmate when I was 3 but then my brother was born. Amin.

My father is kind and he loves us very much but sometimes I think he loves me a little bit more.

I used to spend most of my time playing with toys and things around the room. I wonder if I could call it game. Most of all I was keen on take my toy's bowels out and reassemble them. Of course sometimes I did not use some parts because I believed they were overplus.

I really was a naughty boy. I was fond of animals and I hated killing them for food or anything else. I used to cry when the animals were slaughtered, what a cry.

After my brother my next playmate was a gentle polite girl. She was Samaneh.

My mother related to me that before entering school when I was giving pre-school education tests, examiner asked her that " Has your son already gone to any classes?" and she answered "no" then the examiner said "he is so smart"

I got the top student at first grade of elementary school. My average was 20 of 20. My second grade was as well as first grade. My teacher said "he has never had such a great student."

I registered in a private school at 3rd grade of elementary school. My teacher was a kind and sympathetic woman. I joined to the theater and school choir groups.

That year my average was 20 of 20. We got second in the competition of school choir among the schools of city.

My elementary school passed and I always was the top student then I took apart in exam of Nemonehschool. I got 11th rate so I could register in NemonehDolatischool.

The school had dormitory and children came from neighbouring villages to study.

My mother awakened me every day and gave me a sandwich or something, but in the class the students of dormitory took a slice of bread and had a little of it to not get hungry. they often didn't have enough money to buy something from buffet of school.

At the launch time as we were going to stay in line to have a meal most of students who were from villages had already stayed in line. I remember clearly that in the first days I went too late to have a meal. Their fathers were often Farmer and livestock. What a simplicity and kindness were in their face.



For the first time I felt the hardships of life. When I had to stay at station early in the morning not to miss the bus School and then wait half an hour for a taxi to pay less money, when one of students stole my shoes at P.E. When I had to run to stay in the line to have a meal and after having meal I had to do my dishes.

All of these things were lessons of life for 20 year old boy and then made me a person who his name is Yasinporaskandari.

The first and second grade of Middle School passed and I got new experiences and high grades. I was nominated for student council election in the third grade. After winning the election I did my best to be useful. That year the Principle chose me as student managing director. It means that I was the successor of principle among the students.

Being in a big great school with dorm, kitchen, self-service and dinner room introduced me their concepts of management and planning that helped me become successful. Two students were responsible for closing door of entrance hall at break time so nobody can come to classes until the class would start. Whenever I intended I could get into the hall or even I could open the door because of my managing director Card or I could do anything according to my duty. Of course my duty was so hard according my age.

It was wonderful, every student was responsible for something for example he was either responsible for self service or Hostel or he was the assistant of managing director (my assistant) or doing anything for running the school.

For the first time in my life I became familiar to the concept of power and being superior to others and perhaps for the first time I got so close to my friends proudly.

Of course this pride did not have a good ending and I am glad that it became as an experience for me. The manager should be more humble and more compassionate and work more than others.

One of my teachers was very interesting to me and always talked to me about magnificence and glory of Iranian history and interested me to know Iran better.

After a while, I felt that Iran is all my possession and I love it from bottom of my heart. I love its unique history, its culture and Civilization. I love everywhere of Iran I mean from the mountains of Azerbaijan to the lush greenery of the North also from nomadic areas of khorasan to fertile soil of khozestan and I love brave men and women of balochistan.

I remember name of Iran with every heartbeat.

Truly, I was born to serve my people and my country up-to-the-minute and until my last breath. What a honor is serving people, peace and human society.

I passed Middle School. Although I wasn't the top student like elementary school, I was studious and I had high grade.

I gave Nemoneh high school entrance exam and unexpectedly I passed it. It was initiation into a new life.



As I got accustomed to involve myself in activities, I was eager to face to a high level of responsibilities for students; but it never happened.

As the first grade of high school was passing, my grade was getting worse and worse. Finally at the end of the year my grade was less than 18.

One year passed, there were no success and great experience. For me who was accustomed to try to be the best.

That year, I was insulted a few times and I was a rogue an energetic teenager who seemed to always woo trouble.

I tried to answer or to coin a phrase do egotism so I said that "I was such and such a person" then they said "you said that I was an elite but we don't see any signs of elite."

I remembered that I talked to the kind and patient counsellor of the school at the end of the year about passing a year and I didn't get any great success.

The consultant said "I believe that the future is good and is closer than you think.

He was right.

I didn't understand that day but now I've found it perfectly.

After finishing the first grade of high school, I started to endeavor Around the Clock. Since I had participated in robotics class during the middle school and also I had made some educational Robots and I knew about computer and electronic science a little to go ahead, for the first time in my life I intended to get an inventor. I didn't want to invent simple things, you know what I wanted to make a Splash.

The summer passed and the second grade of High School started. My first invention was ready at Midyear.

I designed a doorbell for deaf people. I supposed if a person Rings the Bell how deaf people get it and then open the door.

It worked, I designed such a system that today I should admit it was satisfactory according to my age.

The deaf people doorbell a wireless connection module of door phone that connects the door phone to a wristlet which is look like a watch. When somebody Rings the Bell the vibration engine inside the wristlet begin to tremble and finally the deaf person finds out that somebody is ringing the Bell. It was time to apply for patent my first invention.

Unfortunately I couldn't obtain the patent because it had already been invented contrary to the impression I wasn't the first person who had designed it.

I approached to the end of school. my endeavors went up in smoke and I didn't become inventor and also I wasn't studious because I just thought about becoming inventor because of that I didn't have enough energy to study.

In second grade of high school I failed for the first time.



It was such a frustration. I just thought about getting stardom but unexpectedly I failed my exams.

I went to the counsellor's room and said "this is my situation, show me the future that you talked about."

Contrary to my thoughts, he said" it doesn't matter at all. You give the exams in September and restart."

I started to study so that I don't fail again.

Exams finished.

They were so hard. But I restart. I restarted to finish the period that I had been an average student but I got a week student.

The first grade of High School started and all of my classmates get in a fluster because of approaching of the university entrance examination. But I didn't care about it and I wanted to finish my work.

I always said" the number of great and successful people is much less than the rest of the people, so if the right way was the way that majority goes, now all people should come to their dreams, so I must dare to say loud I think most of the time majority are not right. I'm here to get to the end of the way that no one has gone.

I came to the end of the third grade of high school and I decided to apply for patent my invention.

As I was engaged in research and development, I used to study less.

Third grade passed. I wasn't studious like second grade and I didn't want to be average student with average grade.

Gradually I started to study for university entrance examination in summer. I was studying for university entrance examination in the last year of school, I was full of energy and of course stress.

I heard in January that I, yasinporskandari, have obtained the patent for the first smartphone for blind people. I obtained the patent of the largest research institution in the country, the organization for scientific and industrial research of Iran. I mean Irost.

It began.

The coming of various officials to our house and congratulations, interviews with newspapers and magazines and various sites.

Shortly thereafter for the first time I appeared on the live TV show and interviewed on the radio, and all this was when I was just 17 years old.

I told to myself that I don't care a fig about University entrance examination. I got ready to go to Tehran, I intended to meet one of the scientists of biomedical engineering to guide me what to do next.



I was a little obsessed for selection of a gift then I went to Tehran.

The professor congratulated me kindly and emphasized that it's useful and important for me to choose the right major and study. He explained a little about the biomedical engineering. A major in which I had entered whether I wanted or not.

I came back from Tehran. There were a few months to university entrance examination, but as if it wasn't exist.

All my friends were sleeping very early at the night before the exam, but I was awake until 5 a.m.

I attended to the exam. What a great exam it was. I was given a cake and a juice and also I had my own cake and juice.

It was funny to see my friends are struggling while I was eating my cake and juice without the stress.

The exam was over and everyone was waiting for the results, except me, because I had already chosen.

After university entrance examination, we moved back to bojnourd City after 20 years.

Of course my father had 4 days off every 12 days. We always spent the 4 days in Bojnourd with our relatives. Because I didn't go out so much in Jajarm, this four-day holiday was enough to have bojnourdyaccent and I call myself kormanj gloriously.

After a little ups and downs, I entered biomedical engineering. I started it when I had a world invention on bioelectric and had consulted with the most great professors.

My second invention, the first mobile gadgets of blinds' cell phone could obtain patent in the third semester of the university and again I got a confirmation of the invention from the Iranian scientific and industrial research organization.

I also established my company in the same semester, now it's time to produce my own inventions in order to blinds of the world could benefit of my many years of research.

But today.

Today that I'm writing this biography is 9/15/2018. I, Yasinporskandari, am the inventor of the first gadget of blinds' cell phone also the first smartphone for blinds in the world. A lot of countries from all over the world have sent me invitation.

Less or much, this is the condition that is result of many years of my work. The days and nights that I cried and sweated because of that I'm in this position now.

Today while I'm writing this biography members of the company are getting ready to produce and market the first gadget mobile for blinds. They work round the clock for about 36 million blinds of the world and about half a million blinds and partially sighteds' of Iran.

Today, the foundation of the company is forming which is result of 20 years of my life.

I hope that we could to get to the end of this hard way and also being helpful for my lovely country and humanity.
